Following this plan will allow you to complete your B.S.B.A. degree in **Management** and the required minor in Business in four years (eight semesters), assuming you meet minimum performance expectations in all courses. Give careful attention to course prerequisites, as they are strictly enforced. If you choose to earn your degree over a period longer than four years, the basic sequence of courses shown above will still apply in most cases. If you decide to deviate from the recommended sequence, you should consult with the College of Business Advising Center for assistance in developing an alternative plan.

¹The Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (B.S.B.A.) with a major in **Management** is a selective admission program. Students enter the program as a Pre-**Management** major. Upon completion of the six courses in the selective admission group (ACC 200, ACC 201, BUS 230, ECO 200, ECO 201, and MKT 205) with a grade of C- or better in each and the achievement of an overall NKU GPA of 2.500 or better, students are officially admitted to the college as a BSBA-

Management major. All transfer students enter as pre-majors and must complete a minimum of 12 credit hours at NKU in order to establish the NKU GPA for selective admission into the major, regardless of individual course completion status. ²Management majors are required to take two 300 or 400 level course electives (6 hours) with the following designators: ENTP, HRM, and MGT (6 credits)
